Search interfaces

Basic Search

Simultaneous search in article title, abstract and keywords or in one of the search fields from the drop-down menu.

Advanced Search
(one or more search fields)

Search with field codes taken from "code suggestions". More search fields are available as in the Basic Search mode.

Author Search

This search mode offers 2 fields – one for the surname and one for the initials / first name. The result can be combined by subject, affiliation or co-authors. Names with umlauts (ä, ö, ü) should be searched additionally without umlaut (simplified) and in dispensed form: *Müller* / *Muller* / *Mueller*.

Truncation / Wildcards

behav*

Finds:

behave, behavior, behaviour, behavioural etc.

(* replaces a string of zero or more characters and can be used at every position)

wom?n

woman or women

(? replaces exactly one character)

Automatic plural search

A singular term finds also plural and possessive forms (day's) of most words (and vice versa) including irregular plural forms (child / children)

Phrase searching (braces or double quotation marks)

{quality management}

Finds:

quality management in exact order next to each other (please note: a simultaneous truncation is not possible, no automatic plural search within phrase searching)

"cell behaviour"

"cell behaviour" in double quotation marks finds loose or approximate phrases (plurals are included, punctuation is ignored (e.g. hyphens), wildcards (*, ?) can be used

Combining search terms with operators

Finds:

cloning **and** human

both terms in the same record

biogas **or** biofuel

at least one of the terms in the same record

animal **not** mouse

„*animal(s)*“, but exclusion of records which contain the term „*mouse*“

cell **pre/5** adult

both terms (in exact order) within 5 words of one another

cell **w/5** adult

both terms if they are within 5 words of one another regardless of the order


Limits

- Date Range
- Document Type
- Subject Areas

Reuse or combining previous search queries/steps from the „search history“ with #n via the field “Combine queries”

#1 and human	AND combination of search step 1 with the term „human“
#1 or #2	OR combination of search step 1 and search step 2
#1 and #2 and not #3	AND combination of search step 1 with search step 2 but exclusion of the results of search step 3

Results

Refine	“Refine” offers an overview (ranking) of the found records. The results within the different categories are listed according to the number of hits. Via “Limit to” or “Exclude” the result can be narrowed.
Export	Scopus offers integrated export functionality with Mendeley and Refworks. To use a different reference manager, choose a file format.
Download	You can download PDF versions of up to 50 documents at the same time. The download might not be successful for all references because of institutional licence conditions. In this case click on the button:  get it (= local holding) which offers you full text access where appropriate.
View citation overview	Citation overview of the selected documents.
View cited by	View documents citing the selected document(s).
Add to list	Create document lists (requires a free registration in advance)
More	View references, Add to my list, Create Bibliography (offers the output in a certain format/style), Email or Print selected results. Via „Search History“ you can „Edit“ and „Save“ previous search questions. The function Set Alert saves a search in a way that it will be started automatically after an update of the database and email the results to a certain address. Both functions require a free registration in advance.
