With this form, you can consent to your personal data being saved and published for the purpose of publication on the University's websites.

If you work as a lecturer or an examiner at the University of Hohenheim, we will create a basic dataset on you in HohCampus so we can enter courses and exams in the system and announce them. A user account is also required to use the platforms to accompany courses (e.g. ILIAS). According to Sec. 12(1) of the State Higher Education Act (LHG), you are therefore required to enter your personal data. Using this form, you can include additional personal data on a voluntary basis for your profile on the University's website. The legal basis for processing the basic dataset is Sec. 4 of the State Data Protection Act (LDSG) in conjunction with Sec. 2 LHG, in all other cases it is based on your consent.

If you work in research or in another function, it is possible to be registered in HohCampus on a voluntary basis for the purpose of publication on the University's website. The legal basis for processing this data is your consent.

In all cases (with no transition period!), all data will be automatically deleted from HohCampus at the end of your course, when your work as an examiner is over, or when the fixed term of your employment contract ends.

Regardless of the type of work you do, with this form you can request an optional HohCampus account for the campus management system. This account enables you to edit your personal data yourself. If you choose not to have this account, we are happy to make changes to your data for you when necessary.

Your consent is voluntary and may be revoked in whole or in part at any time for the future.

Not entering personal data means that this data cannot be processed. If data required for courses and exams is missing, then you will not be permitted to carry out the courses or exams. Not entering voluntary data has no consequences other than it not being possible to publish this data. If you work in research or another function (besides teaching and examining) and do not want the data published, you do not have to do anything.


You have the right to receive information about the processing of your personal data, to correct or delete the data, or to restrict the processing or transferring of the data. You have the right to object to your personal data being processed. You have the right to submit a complaint to the State Data Protection Officer for data protection in Baden-Württemberg.
